



JOB DESCRIPTION

CERTIFIED NURSE ASSISTANT (CNA)

STANDARDS OF PRACTICE

To provide direct patient care under the supervision of a Registered Nurse

1. Current C.N.A. certification in the state of practice
2. Current C.N.A. completion issued through an American Heart Association course
3. Proof of fulfillment of health screening criteria required by American Medical Staffing.
4. Documented evidence of a minimum of 12 months experience
5. Successful completion of the independent studies covering Blood Borne Pathogens, Fire and Electrical Safety and Body Mechanics with score of 80% or greater
6. Successful completion of screening evaluations required for clinical areas in which the Certified Nursing Assistant practices with a minimum score of 80%

FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. CNA is supervised by the American Medical Staffing Director of Nursing
2. Performs basic nursing assistant procedures in accordance with the facility's standards and policies and procedures
3. Maintains patient records and chart to ensure an accurate record of the patient's medical treatment
4. Assists other members of the nursing team
5. Maintains positive behaviors, approaches, attitude and commitment to interpersonal service toward patients, visitors and coworkers
6. Demonstrates appropriate use of safety devices and facility equipment
7. Maintains a safe, comfortable, and therapeutic environment for patients and families in accordance with facility standards
8. Adheres to all American Medical Staffing policies and procedures

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

1. Requires full range of body motion including lifting adult patients, manual and finger dexterity and eye-hand-foot coordination
2. Frequent standing and walking for extended periods of time
3. Ability to push / pull more than 50lbs. And to lift objects more than 20lbs
